First Reconciliation Parent/Student Prayer Services

We work hard to make sure our candidates are well prepared for First Reconciliation and Holy Communion. Remember, from our parent/caregiver meetings that you should be reviewing the Act of Contrition and the Examination of Conscience.

As part of this preparation, all candidates must attend ONE (1) of the three prayer services in preparation in January. These take place in the Church (66 Post Avenue). The services will be offered on:

- Monday, January 12 BREAD Level 2 Reconciliation Prayer Service 5PM**
- Monday, January 12 BREAD Level 2 Reconciliation Prayer Service - 7 PM**
- Wednesday, January 14 BREAD Level 2 2 Reconciliation Prayer Service 6 PM**
